Sleeping

Do Not Bring

- * Alcohol or illegal drugs
- * Weapons (includes all knives)
- * Expensive electronics (laptops, iPods, DVD players, stereos, etc.)
- * Expensive jewellery
- * Chewing gum

Parliamentary Attire

At the overnight accommodations, dress is casual. But while in the legislature, members shall dress according to parliamentary attire. Here are the details:

- **Women:** blouse and/or sweater (shoulders must be covered); skirt, dress, or dress pants (skirts shall end no higher than the top of the knee); dress shoes
- **Men:** dress shirt; tie or bowtie; dress pants; jacket or sweater; dress socks; dress shoes
- **Not to be worn** (read this part carefully): anything low-cut; denim of any kind; running shoes; wallet chains; mandarin ties; open-toed shoes
