Bill 6

Health and Labour Balance Act

WHEREAS "Overwork can lead to serious illness and even death"; and

WHEREAS "Productivity – output per working hour – improves with shorter hours" 2; and

WHEREAS "Access to mental health services is an issue that significantly impacts all Canadians".

THEREFORE, HER MAJESTY, BY AND WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE YOUTH PARLIAMENT OF MANITOBA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 As of January 1, 2017, the Government of Canada shall establish the Healthy Employment Advocacy League [HEAL] to oversee and enforce conditions of employment in Canada.
 - (1) **[HEAL]** shall provide consultation services to employers to immediately commence a 5-year phasing in period to reduce the work week to a maximum of 25 hours for all occupations.
 - (2) Employers and employees shall be equally fined for documented work hours which exceed this condition of employment.
 - (3) Minimum wage in all provinces shall rise proportionally so that a 25-hour workweek will result in the same wage as the current 40-hour workweek.
 - (4) These standards shall apply to all persons working in Canada regardless of the employee's nationality.
- 2 [HEAL] shall be responsible for processing all claims pertaining to workplace stress and anxiety-related risks, and injuries (physical, mental, and emotional).
 - (1) Any occupation deemed as especially high-risk by **[HEAL]** shall be mandated to compensate employees a maximum 25% of their wage or salary as additional stress pay.
- 3 [HEAL] shall subsidize up to 70% of outpatient mental health care services for all Canadian citizens and permanent resident employees.
 - (1) This includes but is not limited to services provided by:
 - (a) Psychiatrists,
 - (b) Psychologists,
 - (c) Psychiatric nurses and,
 - (d) Therapists and counsellors.

- (2) The full cost of services will be subsidized for minors and full-time students of any secondary or post-secondary institution.
- 4 [HEAL] shall administer mandatory clinical assessments by a registered psychiatrist to all persons working in Canada.
 - (1) Persons who range between the ages of 15-20 shall be assessed annually.
 - (a) Full-time students over the age of 20 shall be assessed annually.
 - (2) Employees who range between the ages of 21-80 shall be assessed once every 5 years.
 - (a) Failure to submit to a mandatory assessment may result in:
 - i. An official reprimand
 - ii. The loss of Canadian Pension Plan or Employment Insurance Benefits
 - iii. The ability to claim tax deductions
 - iv. Suspensions of employment
- 5 [HEAL] shall refund 50% of tuition fees for all mental health professionals working in Canada.
 - (1) Tuition pay-back shall be dependent upon the individual graduating from a Canadian post-secondary institution and practicing in Canada for a minimum of 5 years.
