YPM 102's Annual General Meeting



YPM had a productive Annual General Meeting on April 8, 2023, in the UWSA Boardroom at the University of Winnipeg.

The meeting began with an inspiring opening address from YPM alum Karla Atanacio, who shared her experience in civic engagement. Members then had the opportunity to hear about the State of the Corporation from Premier Alexa Mucyo Kayonga, followed by a presentation of the 2023 budget from Deputy Speaker Josephine Zhao, and a Year-In-Review of 2022 from Speaker Jacob Harvey.

In addition to these presentations, YPM also passed amendments to its Bylaws, Standing Orders, and Code of Conduct. These changes were recommended by the Standing Orders and Bylaws Organizational Committee (SOBLOC), chaired by House Leader Charlize Medina.
