# Alumni Spotlight: Deborah Tsao



I am happy to share our next alumni spotlight, highlighting an alumnus I was fortunate to meet and work with during my years in YPM.

Deborah Tsao's YPM journey began as the member from Nose Hill in the 92nd Session. She joined Cabinet in the 93rd Session as the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Public Relations, then the Minister of Public Relations in the 94th

Session. In the 95th Session, Deborah served as the Registrar General, and was elected to the post of Deputy Speaker the same year. Deborah served five years on the Executive, including the Premier of the 98th Session, and twice, the Speaker of the 99th and 100th Session. Deborah was inducted into the Senate in the 101st Session. In her role as Speaker, she undertook several projects in celebration of YPM's 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary, including the research and writing of a YPM history book, the installation of a commemorative plaque in the Manitoba Legislature, and the successful fundraising campaign to raise over \$100,000 for YPM's endowment fund.

In 2018, Deborah graduated from McGill University with a B.Sc. (Hon) and began medical school at Stanford University. While at McGill, Deborah conducted research on the development of neuropathic pain following spinal cord injury and developed a novel optogenetic mouse model of neuropathic pain. While completing her MD at Stanford, Deborah also earned a Master's degree researching the genetics of type 2 diabetes using a fruit fly model of insulin resistance. This year (2024), Deborah graduated from medical school and will begin her General Surgery residency training at the Johns Hopkins Hospital. Congratulations, Dr. Tsao!

Reflecting on her time in YPM, Deborah appreciates the long-lasting effect YPM has on her worldview. Through meeting youth from different backgrounds across the province, she grew to recognize how vast disparities in opportunity can shape lives. This illuminated the role that privilege played in her own life and instilled a life-long commitment to equity. She also credits YPM, particularly during her time on the Executive, with developing her sense of self-confidence. Before YPM, she never imagined that she could manage a budget, plan events for 80+ people, or lead a team of other volunteers. Being thrust into these roles pushed her out of her comfort zone but in doing so, also developed her adaptability, reliability, and self-belief.

As she embarks on her next chapter, Deborah is incredibly grateful to the opportunities that YPM has provided with her. Although the House Chamber might seem very different from an operating room, she has no doubt that the lessons she learned from her time in YPM will remain salient for many more years to come.
